AR "SUPER INCREDIBLE READERS REMINDER

Parents,

As we move forward in the new quarter here are some important things to remember for Accelerated Reader.

- 1. To ensure your child meets the AR goal for the quarter you should plan for half of the points to be achieved by Monday November 25th.
- 2. Students in grades 3-8 **must** have all outside AR books approved by the librarian before going to the library to test.
- 3. Make sure you ask your child about the AR book to ensure he or she understood the story.
 - Ask questions like:
 - 1. What's the story about? 2. Where does it take place? 3. What was the problem?
 - Other questions may be about details from the story. For example:
 - 1. What was Little Red Riding Hood wearing? 2. What was she taking to grandma?
 - 3. What type of character was the wolf? (Kind? Honest? Sneaky?) How do you know?

Prayer Corner: You know God, But does God know You Scripture Reference: Matthew 7:21-27 MSG

You know of famous people. You might follow their lifestyle, quote their sayings, sing their songs, recognize them on TV or radio, and even pray for stressful situations in their life. Does this constitute as knowing this person? Or, more importantly, does this person know you?

God doesn't want you to know Him lightly, He demands a relationship.

In Matthew, Jesus sums it up this way: "Knowing the correct password—saying 'Master, Master,' for instance—isn't going to get you anywhere with me. What is required is serious obedience— doing what my Father wills. I can see it now—at the Final Judgment thousands strutting up to me and saying, 'Master, we preached the Message, we bashed the demons, our Godsponsored projects had everyone talking.' And do you know what I am going to say? 'You missed the boat. All you did was use me to make yourselves important. You don't impress me one bit. You're out of here.'

"These words I speak to you are not incidental additions to your life, homeowner improvements to your standard of living. They are foundational words, words to build a life on. If you work these words into your life, you are like a smart carpenter who built his house on solid rock. Rain poured down, the river flooded, a tornado hit—but nothing moved that house. It was fixed to the rock."

"But if you just use my words in Bible studies and don't work them into your life, you are like a stupid carpenter who built his house on the sandy beach. When a storm rolled in, and the waves came up, it collapsed like a house of cards.""

You have a relationship with your children. If you only mentioned what they said and did, but never spoke with them directly, consistently, and daily, you wouldn't have much of a relationship. And if you only spoke with them weekly, monthly, quarterly, and yearly, you wouldn't have a relationship either.

God demands an intimate relationship with each of us. At the end of our lives, everyone will meet a loving, gracious Father. Some He will say, "Good and faithful servant," others "Depart from me, I know you not." Since you are reading this, it's still time to get the response you desire. Start today as long as today is called today.
